

Through its Foundation, Institución San Patricio offers **Academic Excellence Scholarships** to carry out *Bachillerato* (11th- and 12th-grade) studies at Colegio San Patricio in Toledo(*) and in Madrid (El Soto de la Moraleja). In this way, its aim is to support students who have an excellent academic record, so that a lack of economic resources does not impede them from studying *Bachillerato* at one of the most prestigious educational centers in the Community of Madrid or in the Community of Castile-La Mancha.

(*)At Colegio San Patricio in Toledo: only in the category of International Baccalaureate.

This type of scholarship is aimed at students who are not studying, or have not studied in the last four years, at Institución San Patricio.

Requirements:

- Achievement of a minimum average of 8.5 out of 10 points, or equivalent, in the three years prior to *Bachillerato* (8th, 9th and 10th grades).
- A minimum B2 level in Spanish and English.
- Official documentation demonstrating the parents' or legal guardians' incomes or revenues available in the last 3 years.

In the case of documentation in languages different to Spanish, they must be sworn translations.

Benefits:

The endowment of each scholarship will consist of being able to carry out *bachillerato* (11th- and 12th-grade) studies at Colegio San Patricio (in Madrid or in Toledo) in the category chosen by the student (*); attending and participating in all official academic and school activities.

The scholarship endowment consists of a percentage of the school's total fees, possibly reaching 100% of said fees. This percentage will be established according to certain criteria established by the Academic Committee for Granting Academic Excellence Scholarships, striking a balance between the average mark and economic revenues.

The scholarships do not include the following services: transport, extracurricular classes, a personal computer, a graphing calculator, registration fees or external examinations (for example, IB exam fees, obtaining language certificates such as Cambridge, Oxford, DELE, Alliance Française, Goethe Institut, etc...)

In the case of the scholarship for the International Baccalaureate, the registration and exam fees associated with obtaining said title are excluded from the endowment.

Besides tuition, the scholarships for the center in Toledo include full room and board at the residence. In this sense, the candidate must bear in mind the Christmas, Easter and summer holiday periods, in which the residence is closed.

The scholarships for the center in Madrid include tuition, canteen service and school bus transport adapted to the established routes.

Documentation:

Interested parties should present the following documentation in person at the Fundación San Patricio head office, or by post or e-mail.

1. The corresponding Academic Excellence Scholarship application form, duly filled in.
2. Academic Certification of the student's marks achieved in the last three years before Bachillerato. At the moment of applying, the marks of the current year obtained until that moment will be presented.
3. Official certification of the student's language levels.
4. Presentation by the student stating his or her reasons for applying for the scholarship. In the case of not being in Spanish, it has to be in English.
5. Official documentation proving the level of family income. In Spain, a copy of the parents' or legal guardians' tax return from the past three years.
6. Authorization for the Foundation to request a report on the candidate from the original school.

Stages of the Process:

- Reception and analysis of the documentation presented by the Fundación.
- Personal interviews with the candidate and his or her family by the Fundación (separate and together).
- Acceptance of the candidate and proposal of a scholarship by the Fundación.

- Admission tests and personal interviews at the requested center.
- A final decision will be communicated in writing by the Fundación.

Application and Decision Deadlines:

The deadline for presenting applications together with all of the documentation ends on **the last working day in February every year.**

- **By the last working day in April every year,** the Scholarship Committee will communicate its final decision in writing to every student who has presented the application.

Scholarship renewal:

The scholarships are applied for annually, even though when they are granted, it implies both years of "*bachillerato*" (11th and 12th grades). In order to maintain the scholarship, it is necessary to fulfill the previously described requirements every year, with a special emphasis with regards to academic performance and personal attitude.
